ON-GOING MINISTRY

PILL BOTTLE DONATION PROJECT

Place clean bottles in the collection bin in the Donation Hall (to your right as you enter through the main doors).

Matthew 25 Ministries sends bottles for reuse in developing countries – improving medical care and caring for the environment.

Acceptable collection items include:

- Prescription and over-the-counter pill bottles - Large and small pill bottles
- Pill bottles with and without secure/child resistant caps. The cap needs to be included with the bottle

How to prepare pill bottles for donation:

- Sort bottles by color and type
- Remove labels, leaving no glue or residue
- Wash bottles and lids in very hot water and dish soap
- Rinse and dry thoroughly then replace lids
- Place clean, recapped bottles in large resealable bags marked "Clean Bottles"
